### 4. VIREC Plans Primary Web Site on VHA Intranet

VIREC currently maintains almost identical Internet and Intranet Web sites (at [www.virec.research.med.va.gov](http://www.virec.research.med.va.gov) and [REDACTED], respectively). The Center is planning to make its primary Web presence on the VHA Intranet and to maintain a limited presence on the Internet. The change will make it easier to comply with Office of Communications requirements for Internet Web sites, and it will be possible for VIREC to provide researchers with information and hyperlinks to VA information sources that cannot be put on an Internet site. VA-affiliated researchers will be able to utilize the Intranet site from any computer within the VA firewall or by using the VA Virtual Private Network (VPN). The VIREC Help Desk will continue to be accessible through both the Internet and Intranet Web sites. VIREC expects that the change will be completed by the end of the calendar year.
